So it was decided to send a proposal for the construction of some classrooms to UGC for financial assistance.

The Internal Quality Assurance Cell functions under the guidance of the Quality Advisory Committee which has been constituted under the chairmanship of the head of the Institution. The IQAC establishes procedure to collect data and information on various aspects and submits a yearly report to NAAC.

1. Activities reflecting the goals and objectives of the Institution

3. Innovation in Curricular Design and Transaction

The Syllabus is already framed by the concerning Board of Studies of RTM Nagpur University. Departmental Meetings are held to discuss regarding the syllabus and implementation of it effectively. Some proper suggestions were sent to board of studies regarding the problems in practicals.

4. Interdisciplinary programmes started

1. B.Com With Computer Application- Part I has total six papers. Out of six papers, four papers are of Commerce and two papers are of computers and contain practical. In B.Com with Computer Application Part III there are two papers of commerce and four papers of Computer. The Commerce papers are taught by the teachers teaching in commerce faculty and the computer papers are taught by the teachers teaching computer Science.
2. In B.Sc. Microbiology Part I, Part II and part III there are some common chapters from Botany and Zoology syllabus. So those chapters are taught by the Botany and Zoology teachers.
3. The Syllabus of communication skill in English (COP) of B.A./B.Com/ B.Sc /is taught by teachers of English Department.

5. **Examination Reforms Implemented:-** As a part of students' evaluation college conducts unit tests and first and second terminal examinations every year which are compulsory for all students. Heavy fine is charged on absent students. The university examination is conducted in accordance to the rules and regulations of RTM Nagpur University. The invigilation work is made compulsory to all regular teachers. RTM Nagpur University has made some changes in the conduction of University Examination. The college has implemented those changes effectively.

6. **Candidate Qualified NET/SET/GATE etc.**

Contributory lecturers (guest lecturers) working in the college on clock Hour basis have to clear either NET or SLET. They appear for the Examination. College purchased books useful for NET or SLET in library.
