PART B

The Internal Quality Assurance Cell functions under the guidance of the Quality Advisory Committee which has been constituted under the chairmanship of the head of the Institution. The IQAC establishes procedure to collect data and information on various aspects and submits a yearly report to NAAC.

1. Activities reflecting the goals and objectives of the Institution

The goals and objectives of the institution, which are displayed at the entrance of the college and published in the college prospectus every year, are to promote education in rural area and development of human personality of the individual in all its aspects – physical, mental and moral. College tries to achieve these goals and objectives through various programmes such as Literary Association, Science Association, Social Science Association, Botanical Society, Zoological Society, Excursion, Study Tours of various departments, NSS, NCC, Adult Education etc which are related to co-curricular and extra curricular activities.

2. New Academic Programmes Initiated

P.G.Level---UGC has approved PG courses in the subjects of Zoology and Medicinal Plant in Science Faculty. In Arts Faculty following subjects are approved by RTM Nagpur University—Marathi, English, Pol. Science. There are no admissions in the subjects of Economics and history. It is decided to start PG in Commerce faculty from the session 2015-16.

3. Innovation in Curricular Design and Transaction

Dr.A.K.Zingare, HOD, Botany was nominated by RTM Nagpur University to cooperate to frame the syllabus of the newly approved Innovative programme of PG course in Medicinal Plant.

Dr.F.M.Nirwan works in the Board of study of Commerce for the subject of Computer Science.

Dr.A.S.Nitnaware and Dr.S.M.Tappe are involved in the work of framing the syllabus of Marathi and English respectively.

4. Interdisciplinary programmes started

1. In B.Sc. Microbiology Part I, Part II and part III, there are some common chapters from Botany and Zoology syllabus. So those chapters are taught by the teachers of Botany and Zoology.

3. The Syllabus of communication skill in English (COP) of B.A./B.Com/ B.Sc/is taught by teachers of English Department.

4. The syllabus of Functional English in B.A.I, II & III is taught by the teachers of English Department.

5. The syllabus of Diploma in Medicinal Plant (COP) is taught by the teachers of Botany Department.

5. Examination Reforms Implemented:- As a part of students' evaluation college conducts unit tests and first and second Terminal Examinations every year which are compulsory for all students. Heavy fine is charged on absent students. The University examination is conducted in accordance to the rules and regulations of RTM Nagpur University. The invigilation work is made compulsory to all regular teachers. RTM Nagpur University has made some changes in the conduction of University Examination. The college implemented those changes effectively.

Manoharbai Patel College of Arts, Commerce & Science, Sakoli, Dist Bhandara (M.S.) organized a One Day UGC Sponsored National Seminar in English on “ Indian Poetry in English-Last Sixty Years “ on 21st December, 2015. Hon’ble Rajendra Jain, MLC and Secretary of Gondia Education Society, Gondia presided over the inaugural function.

The Seminar was inaugurated at the hands of DR. Madhavi Nikam, head, Deptt. of English, R.K. Talreja college, Ulhasnagar, Thane. The Key-note address was delivered by Dr. Madhavi Nikam. In the First Session, Dr. Onkar Nath Upadhyay, Professor and head, Deptt. of English, Lucknow University, Lucknow delivered his well prepared speech on Indian English Poetry-Nature, Background and the present position. Dr. Soma Sen, Deptt. of English, P.G.T.D. RTM Nagpur University, Nagpur delivered her speech on “Imagery and Diction in the poetry of Jayant Mahaparta. Dr. Urmila Dabir, principal and head, Deptt. of English, Rajkumar Kewalramani College, Nagpur presided over the session.

A. Lab to land programme

1. Physics –A team of students of Physics Department of our college visited to a nearby village Jambhali/sadak under the banner of Lab to Land programme in Physics on Wednesday, 23rd Sept.2015.Groups of three students were formed to visit house to house at the village Jambhali/sadak. They informed the villagers the different ways and techniques of saving energy. With the help of different types of LED lamps, they explained the difference between the intensity of incandescent lamps and LED lamps. They also guided regarding the precautions which should be taken during the daily use of

electrical instruments and appliances. It was observed that many villagers were using incandescent lamps of high wattage. Students informed them about the consumption of common lamps. They also informed regarding the generation of electricity at power stations and the importance of its saving.

2. Chemistry – The Members of Chemistry Department of Manohar Bhai Patel College have visited two different villages namely-Dharmapuri and Khamba/Jambhali in Sakoli taluka.They provided the valuable information regarding the fixation of nitrogen,the importance of main elements and micro elements like-B.Fe,Mo and Zn etc.They provided the information of using artificial manures and their side effects to the farmers in the villages.
